



RACE RULES

TARVISIO SUMMER TRAIL 2023 "à Malfi"

➤ **Art. 1 - Acceptance of the regulation**

The 2nd. edition of the Tarvisio Summer Trail "à Malfi" will take place Saturday 16.09.23 at the Upper Lake of Fusine (UD), on the trails of the basin of the Lakes of Fusine and Mount Mangart.

The scheduled races are as follows:

Monte Mangart Summer Trail:

competitive race (route: 15.7 Km with 920 m D+), reserved for those born by 31.12.2007.

The ABSOLUTE ranking (M/F) will be drawn up as well as a ranking for the following categories (M/F):

- MASTER A: born from 1974 to 1983;
- MASTER B: born from 1964 to 1973;
- MASTER C: born before 1964.

Trail del due laghi: non-competitive race open to all (route: 10.7 km with 200 m D+).

Participation in the Tarvisio Summer Trail implies the acceptance, in all its parts and without reservation of these official regulations. By registering each competitor undertakes to respect it and frees the organizers from any civil or criminal liability for any accident, for damage to persons or things derived from him and caused by himself, that may occur before, during and after the event.

The event takes place in a mountain environment and therefore it is recommended to take all necessary precautions.

Art.2 - Organization committee

The event is organized by the "U.S. Mario Tosi Tarvisio" under the patronage of the Municipality of Tarvisio. The event is organized and named in memory of Mariano Malfitana, former President of the organizing company, athlete, ski instructor, coach, and organizer of many sporting events, including the Etna Marathon, the Tarvisio Winter Trail, the Alpine Relay of Mount Lussari and many others.



Art.3 - Registration procedure

Online registrations will close on 11.09.23. Registration will be communicated through the social channels "Tarvisio Trail Running". For information athletes can contact the organization at

The registration fees are fixed in:

Monte Mangart Summer Trail:

- Online by 31.07: 25,00 Euro;
- Online by 20.08: 30,00 Euro;
- Online until 11.09: 35,00 Euro;
- Euro 40,00 Euro for entries made up to one hour before the start of the race (subject to availability of race bibs).

The registration fee includes: race bib with chips, assistance and refreshments along the way, participation in the pasta-party, race pack with T-shirt CRAZY IDEA, finisher medal.

Trail dei due Laghi: 20,00 for registrations made online by 11.09.23, Euro 25,00 Euro for registrations made up to an hour before the start of the race.

The registration fee includes: race bib, assistance and refreshments along the way, participation in the pasta-party, race pack with T-shirt CRAZY IDEA.

All applications must be accompanied by the documentation required in art. 4 penalty exclusion from participation in the event. The payment of the registration includes all the services described in this regulation. Each member can verify the completion of the registration by visiting the website <https://www.tarvisiotrailing.com> and accessing the registration link. The registration will be considered completed only when the organizing company has received all the required documentation as indicated in art. 4 of the Regulation.

Art. 4 - Admission conditions for competitors

The Monte Mangart Summer Trail will be open to athletes born by 31.12.2007. In particular:

a) Athletes in possession of CSI, FIDAL and MOUNTAIN & TRAIL RUNCARD or RUNCARD valid on the day of the event, then in possession of the Competitive Medical Certificate.



b) Athletes not registered but in possession of the Certified Medical Agonistic with marking for endurance sports (athletics, running, trail, cycling, cross-country skiing, ski touring, etc.) valid on the date of the event, may sign a daily CSI card at an extra cost of 10 Euro . The card guarantees insurance cover for the event. The form to be completed and the card will be handed over to the race office.

The registered athlete who for his own reasons will not be able to participate in the race, will not have the opportunity to postpone the registration to the 2024 edition, to transfer it to another athlete or to request a refund of the paid fee.

Art. 5 - Rankings and prizes

The following prizes and awards will be awarded
Prizes Mount Mangart Summer Trail:

- ABSOLUTE ranking (M/F): from 1 to 5 classified technical articles and/or food and wine awards. The first place will also be awarded the third trophy "Mariano Malfitana";
- MASTER A classification (M/F): from 1 to 3 classified technical articles and/or food and wine awards;
- MASTER B classification (M/F): from 1 to 3 classified technical articles and/or food and wine awards;
- MASTER C classification (M/F): from 1 to 3 classified technical articles and/or food and wine awards. L'atleta appartenente ad una delle categorie MASTER a cui viene consegnato uno dei premi della classifica ASSOLUTA, perde il diritto al premio della sua categoria di appartenenza.

Recognition participation in the Trail del due Laghi: all participants will be given the finisher medal and gadget of the event.

Art. 6 - Delivery of race bibs and race package

The delivery of the bibs will take place on the day of the event up to 30 minutes before the scheduled time of departure at the race office set up on the race field. The delivery of race-bibs will not take longer than the time indicated in this regulation, so it is recommended to arrive at the departure in good time.

The obligatory equipment to be carried during the event will be checked at the entrance to the departure area. Controls of the obligatory material will also be performed along the route and on arrival with disqualification in case of absence of the expected material.

At the withdrawal of the race package will be entitled only to athletes registered in the race who have regularly presented and registered at the start. The race package will be delivered at the end of the race, before the awards ceremony, after showing the punched starting bib.



Art. 7 - Race track

Please refer to the website for detailed information on the route.

Art. 8 - Punching and checks at departure

The bib must be pinned in front, so that it is clearly visible, the chip must be worn and 30 minutes before departure will be punched.

Art. 9 - Control points

The control points are distributed along the entire route and will have the task of recording the passage of competitors and controlling the mandatory material (sample). The punching carried out at the control points will allow the arrival to establish the passage of the athletes. It is mandatory that athletes make sure that their passage has been recorded.

Art. 10 - Withdrawal

In case of withdrawal, the competitor must inform the organization's staff as soon as possible. The race-bib will then be collected at one of the control or refreshment points. The reporting of their withdrawal is essential to avoid alerting the emergency vehicles in case of no arrival of athletes. It is mandatory that athletes who have decided to withdraw do so at the checkpoints or refreshment.

Art. 11 - Description of the route

The route description in the most updated version will be available on the organization's website. Competitors are invited to take a careful look. Any changes will be published on the site.

Art. 12 - Safety and medical assistance

Safety and medical assistance will be provided by the staff of the organization located on the route. Rescue vehicles will move along the route in areas accessible to vehicles in use. Managers on duty are allowed to stop competitors deemed unfit to continue the event, in which case the race number will be withdrawn.

Each athlete has the obligation, under penalty of disqualification, to assist other athletes in any difficulty and to report to the staff of the organization situations that require rescue or help. The broom service, the rescue vehicles, the organization's cars, the control posts, are equipped with radio in permanent contact with the logistic base of the event. The competitor who appeals to a rescuer submits in fact to his authority and undertakes to respect his decisions. The choice of care and its nature will be left to the decision of the medical staff. One or more volunteers of the organization will ensure the closing of the race and will follow the last competitor. In any case, the race will be closed at the end of the maximum time of passage to cancello.

Art. 13 - Insurance

The organisation takes out liability insurance for the duration of the trial. Participation in the event takes place under the entire responsibility of the competitors, who with their registration waive any appeal against



the organizers in the event of damage and further consequences that may arise to them following the event.

Art. 14 - Refreshment points, food drinks

2 refreshment points will be established along the route of Monte Mangart Summer Trail (Rifugio Zacchi and finish line). Refreshment points will be provided with drinks and groceries.

Art. 15 - Bags of competitors

Service not provided.

Art. 16 - Mandatory equipment

It must be taken along the entire route of the Trail:

- Use of Trail Running shoes;
- Long sleeve t-shirt and cap or bandana in case of adverse weather conditions.

In case of favorable weather conditions, the organizing committee may decide to remove the obligation to use long-sleeved shirt, cap or bandana, communicating it at the time of delivery of race bibs.

Art. 17 - Maximum time

The maximum race time for Monte Mangart Summer Trail is 3h00'. A time gate will be established and will be indicated in the route description.

The employees of the organization will be adamant in blocking the athletes who will arrive at the gate hours out of time, this to ensure the safety of participants and volunteers on the path. There is also a broom service that will run along the track following the last competitor, so as to be of help to the retirees and prevent any injured remain without assistance.

Please note that every athlete is required to ensure that their passage is recorded at each checkpoint.

Art. 18 - Penalties and disqualifications

The staff of the organization on the route is entitled to check the mandatory material and in general compliance with the entire regulation. All competitors not found in possession, at the time of the control on the route, of the totality of their mandatory material will be immediately disqualified, without any possibility of appeal on this sanction.

The organization can decree the disqualification of a competitor in case of non-compliance with the aforementioned regulation or in particular of:

- Exchange of race-bib or chip;
- Failure to pass to a checkpoint;
- Cutting of the path;
- Lack of part or all of the compulsory equipment;
- Use of a means of transport;
- Departure from a checkpoint after the time barrier expires;



- Mancata assistenza a un altro atleta in caso di difficoltà;
- Abandonment of own material on the path;
- Pollution or degradation of the place with abandonment of waste on the path;
- Insults, rudeness or threats to members of the organization or volunteers;
- Refusal to be examined by a rescuer of the organization at any time of the event;
- Physical and/ or psychic State deemed unsuitable for the continuation.

Art. 19 - Complaints

Any complaints can be submitted to the organization of the race within 30 minutes from the publication and exposure of the results. In keeping with the spirit of the race, it is hoped that the athletes will be completely correct.

Art. 20 - Changes to the route or cancellation of the event

The organization reserves the right to change at any time the route or location of the control and refreshment posts, without any notice. In case of unfavorable weather conditions (cold, rain, high risk of thunderstorms or anything that in the opinion of the organization is dangerous for athletes), the start can be postponed or canceled, or the route can be changed and/ or reduced . In the event of adverse weather conditions involving safety reasons, the organization reserves the right to suspend the current event or to change the time barriers.

In case of cancellation for reasons of force majeure, not attributable to the organization, 50% of the paid registration fee, net of commissions, will be refunded. This percentage is justified by the multiple expenses that the Organization has already made and that it cannot recover.

In case of interruption or cancellation of the race due to weather reasons, or for any other cause independent of the Organization, no refund will be due to the participants.

In case of impossibility to participate in the race, you will be entitled to a refund of 60% of the registration fee only in case of presentation of the medical certificate.

All refunds will be made within 60 days of the event ending.

Art. 21 - Processing of personal data, photographic, television and video coverage.

By registering, the competitor authorizes the organization to process personal data pursuant to Legislative Decree 196/2003 "Code on the protection of personal data". Any athlete participating in the event may request the cancellation of their data by sending a written request to the U.S. Mario Tosi - Tarvisio.

In addition, the competitor expressly waives the right to use his image during the trial, as well as waives any appeal against the organization and its authorized partners for the use made of his image.

Art. 22 - Declaration of Liability

Participation in the TARVISIO SUMMER TRAIL entails the acceptance by the registered competitor in all its parts and without reservation of this regulation.

Upon sending the registration form, the participant declares that he has read, understood and accepted in



its entirety the present rules of the event, relieves the organization of any civil and criminal liability for damages to things and people caused in the course of the race and confirms that you are in possession of the medical certificate valid on the date of the event for competitive sports (athletics, in particular running). D.L. 196/03. Protection of privacy: personal data will be processed for the sole purpose of providing the service in oggetto e non saranno divulgati né utilizzati per altre finalità.

Art. 23 - Amendments to the regulation

The organization reserves the right to change the rules, to improve the same, by publishing the changes in real time on the official website www.tarvisiotrailrunning.com or by giving information through their social channels.
